

Strategic Research and Extension Plan of the Agricultural Technology Management Agency, Kohima district has been prepared with a vision of utilizing technology, tools and techniques available to improve and modernize agricultural practices in order to ensure that the true potential of farmers is harnessed. The plan seeks to re-enforce viable technologies which will improve the agricultural income of the farmers in the district. The plan projects a multi-dimensional approach with special emphasis on Agriculture and allied departments.

The plan divides the district into 2 (two) Agro-Ecological Situation Zones and for each zone separate strategies have been envisaged as Block Action Plan (BAP) which leads to the development of District Action Plan (DAP).

The introduction of ATMA programme as a part of extension reforms in India is taking place in the district for the first time. It appears that the Agriculture & Allied departments working together to thresh out strategies basing on the information and data collected from the grass root level is a convergence in reality as envisaged by the reform policy.

I am happy to see the SREP documents developed by the team keeping farmers and agricultural development as a common goal which is a positive sign in changing agricultural scenario in the district.
